## Show Rules

1. All exhibitors must abide by the rules of the North West FFCC.
2. All birds must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor.
3. All entries must be checked in by a steward.
4. Birds to be exhibited in black Dewar cages only with drinker and sufficient seed to last through the show. Tierwohl/Chipsi/Gold Chip/Snowflake and similar soft wood chip products accepted as cage floor covering, spars of show cages to be placed so as to leave five empty wires between them, first spar to be on the drinker hole wire, cage labels to be placed directly under spar away from drinker.
5. All birds to be benched by 8:30am to enable the judging to commence at 9:00am prompt. No birds will be accepted after judging has started (unless permission has been granted by the show manager.)
6. No dirty cages will be accepted.
7. Under no circumstances will cage labels be altered on the day of the show.
8. No bird will be re-classed for any reason.
9. Only judges, stewards and club officials will be allowed in the show hall during judging.
10. The committee has the right to refuse entry to any person not abiding by the show rules.
11. The committee reserves the right to appoint additional judges if necessary.
12. Judges shall be instructed to disqualify dyed or trimmed birds.
13. The judge's decision shall be final unless fraud or misrepresentation is proven.
14. No birds to be removed from the show hall without the permission of the show manager.
15. Any exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest must deposit £10 to the show manager at least 1 hour before the end of the show. The deposit will be returned if the protest is upheld. The decision of the committee is final.
16. The committee has the right to refuse entry to any exhibitor without explanation.
17. Any matters not covered in these rules will be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final.

**DEFRA** - With new legislation in place, all birds must be looked at before staging. Any bird showing signs of ill health will be refused entry and removed from the show hall. If you have any aviary with outdoor access or keep any type of poultry breed on the same premises as your canaries you must now register with DEFRA.
