SHOW RULES

- 1. All Exhibitors agree to abide by the Rules of Northwest F.F.C.C
- 2. All Birds must be the Bona Fide property of the Exhibitor.
- 3. All Entries must be checked in by a Steward.
- 4. All Birds to be Staged in a Standard Dewar show cage with drinker and sufficient seed to last through the show and with floor covering of Tierwhol/Chipsi, Gold Chip Original or Soft Chip.
- 5. All Birds to be Benched by 8.30am to enable the Judging to commence at 9.00am Prompt. No Birds will be accepted after the Judging has commenced, unless permission is granted by the Show Manager.
- 6. No Dirty Cages will be accepted
- 7. Under No circumstances will Cage labels be altered on the day of the show.
- 8. Any Bird wrongly classed by the exhibitor will Not be re-classed.
- 9. Stewards and officials only allowed in the Show Hall during judging.
- 10. The Committee has the Right to refuse entry to any person not abiding by the show rules.
- 11. The Committee reserve the right to appoint an extra Judge if the necessity arises.
- 12. Judges shall be instructed to disqualify Dyed or Trimmed birds.
- 13. Judges Decision is Final unless Fraud or Misrepresentation is proven.
- 14. No birds to be removed from the show hall without the Show Manager's Decision.
- 15. Any exhibitor wishing to lodge a Protest must deposit £10 to the Show Manager at least One hour prior to close of the show. The deposit will only be returned if if the protest is upheld, The Decision of the Committee is Final
- 16. Any Matters Not Covered in These Rules Will Be Referred to The Show Committee whose Decision Shall Be Final.

SOME IMPORTANT CHANGES

Here's hoping you have bred a few winners for this year's shows. There have been some changes voted in over the last year:

First change being the more relaxed approach to the show cage floor covering, with increased costs and irregular supply of some products, you now have a choice of products which are all acceptable - Tierwhol/Chipsi, Gold Chip Original or Soft Chip.

Second change, the word foul has been removed from the classes. Self-birds now have their own classes. Any bird that is more than 50% variegated will now go in the heavily variegated classes. As always there will be borderline cases (lighter feather under the beak for example) but I can assure you our top line up of judges will always use common sense in these cases.

The Fife Canary Council have also introduced a 6-bird nomination competition for all take part in as an extra bit of interest for exhibitors with £50 prize for both Champion and Novice. Don't forget to nominate the 6 birds on your entry form (cannot be changed later) (first 6 Entries will qualify for nominations prize if you have not marked your choice) Details of points to be awarded (in line with the Fife Canary Council Fancier of the Year competition) are as follows:

Class win 5 points - Colour specials win 10 points - Best in section Champion/Novice 15 points
